SCHOOL BEGINS

The 2017/18 school year starts on Monday, August 14, 2017 for grades 7-12 and Wednesday, August 16, 2017 for grades K-6. This will be a full school day for all students - 7:50 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. School lunch will be served.

An optional student activity fee is available to students for the following prices: \$25.00 for grades K-6, \$30.00 for grades 7-8 and \$40.00 for grades 9-12. This fee will cover all student activities sponsored by student government and athletic events.

A laboratory fee will be charged for classes such as Welding, Art and Weight Training.

PRE-REGISTRATION

All Pk-8 students who will be enrolling for the first time in the Cheyenne County Public Schools are asked to pre-register at the Elementary School on July 31st, - August 10th from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. All new 9-12 grade students will register at the High School during the

PRE-SCHOOL

NO CHARGE THIS YEAR DUE TO FUNDING. (When funding is not available)
There will be a \$75.00 per month fee for your child to attend preschool. You may either pay by month, by semester (\$337.50) or in one lump sum (\$675.00). The rates will change if you

KINDERGARTEN

To be eligible for Kindergarten a student must be five years of age on or before July 1, 2015. Parents, as required by law, must provide a birth certificate for proof of birth date and a completed immunization record.

Any student who has not attended Kindergarten and enrolls in first grade must be six years of age on or before July 1, 2015.
